OUR CHARITIÉS

The Summer Festival is our Community Group's largest annual fundraising event and the money we raise helps many different people. Here's a glimpse of how we spent the RMB 200,000 raised at our 2013 event...

LOCAL ORPHANAGE – DONATED RMB 63,000 & HUNDREDS OF PARENT VOLUNTEER HOURS

Since our school began in 2002 the Community Group has supported a local orphanage that is home to over 130 children, most of whom have a physical or mental disability. We provide support in the following ways:

- Organize parent volunteers to go on weekly visits to play with the children,
- Provide a weekly delivery of protein rich foods to ensure that the children's diet is nutritious and well balanced (annual cost RMB 60,000), and
- Provide RMB 3,000 for a Chinese New Year Party for the children and hongbaos for orphanage ayis.

Our commitment to this orphanage is ongoing. A successful 2014 Summer Festival will make it possible to continue our food programme, which has dramatically improved the children's health.

SHANGHAI SUNRISE – DONATED RMB 63,000

www.shanghaisunrise.com Via Shanghai Sunrise our community has provided educational scholarships for 16 under-privileged Shanghai high school and university students. These children come from extremely poor families and without our ongoing financial support they would be unable to complete their studies.

The success of our 2013 event, combined with further Community Group fundraising in 2014, allowed our Community Group to not only meet our annual charitable expenses but also to make additional donations to:

HOME SWEET HOME FOUNDATION - RMB 21,500

Home Sweet Home provides training and employment for Shanghai's homeless and disabled adults.

HEART TO HEART – RMB 50,000

This money will cover the complete cost of heart surgeries for two children with congenital heart defects whose families would otherwise be unable to fund the necessary operations.

BAOBEI FOUNDATION - RMB 20,000

www.baobeifoundation.org This group works with Shanghai medical professionals to provide life saving neurological and gastrointestinal surgeries to Chinese orphans.

CERECARE WELLNESS – RMB 10,000

Cerecare Wellness is a residential treatment center for children with cerebral palsy. Five children from our local orphanage receive treatment here.

SHINING STAR – RMB 10,000

Shining Star is a foster home that seeks to help prepare visually impaired and blind orphans for entry into school in China or for adoption in China or abroad. We first met several of the children now living at this home at the local orphanage we support.
