- World Water Day
 - Friday 21 March World Water Day is approaching. We will be celebrating the vital resource of 'water' on Friday through lessons and activities designed to inspire and inform about many different aspect of water. We hope to raise money for Water Aid (http://www.wateraid.org/) as we did last year through pupils designing and painting (on their own faces, hands, arms etc) water inspired images. Unfortunately, face paints will not be available at school but this can still be done at home. Alternatively pupils can create water inspired badges to wear on their school uniform during the day. Literacy

The focus for this week will be to complete the story plan and commence writing a first draft of their story set in a fantasy world. This will be an extended piece of writing, which will be reviewed and edited and the children will be encouraged to present it using their own ideas. As part of the speaking and listening aspect of the Literacy curriculum, the children will also be presenting their homework projects, giving them the opportunity to speak in front of an audience and communicate ideas effectively.

Maths

The focus will move to using multiplication and division with specific reference to the 6 and 8 times tables. The children will learn and practise efficient mental methods. Where appropriate they will also learn to use formal and informal written methods. They will solve problems and apply their skills to real life situations. They will be encouraged to look for patterns and relationships between numbers.

Themed Learning

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Science

The children will explore different melting points of solids. They will also complete practical activities where they dissolve solids in water. They will learn to use equipment accurately and carefully and to record their results in a variety of different forms.

Art

The children will be looking at the Global Classroom competition, which entails creating an illustration to do with change. They will explore the different forms change can take and experiment with how to communicate this visually.

Literacy – fantasy, setting, stories, characters, paragraph, edit, theme, storyline, character, intentions, purpose, dilemma, solution, resolution, presentation, articulate, projection.

Maths – using, applying, team work, problem solving, analyzing, logical thinking, multiplication, division, relationships, grids, columns, efficient

Themed Learning

Science – solid, liquid, property, classify, molecules, fill, container, pour, solution, dissolve, melt, filter, solute, evaporate.

Art – illustration, change, communicate, visual, tools, lines, draw.

De focus zal de komende week liggen op het herhalen en oefenen van technishce vaardigheden, zoals de spellingcategorieën en grammatica. In groep 6 en groep 7 wordt daarnaast hard gewerkt aan het de tegenwoordige tijd en de verleden tijd van zwakke (klankvaste) en sterke (klankveranderende) werkwoorden. Ook richten we onze aandacht op het veranderen van zinnen in enkelvoud en meervoud en analyseren we daaraan gekoppelde congruëntiefouten.


