

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be exploring several short stories and the different features used to write a story. These will include adverbials, paragraphs, adjectives and prepositions.

In **Numeracy**, we will be extending our knowledge of numbers up to 1,000,000 by ordering and comparing numbers. We will also be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 and understanding our knowledge of place value in decimal numbers. Finally, we will be looking at problems with adding and subtracting decimal numbers.

In **Science**, we will be exploring, through modelling, that the Sun does not move. We will be creating a model of the solar system using scaling to help make our models accurate. We will be using our knowledge from Numeracy to help draw the circles such as diameter and circumference.

In **IPC**, we will be starting our entry point for 'The Great, the Bold and the Brave'. We will be looking and identifying Greek and Roman buildings in readiness for constructing our own interpretation of one. We will use card, paper and tape to create our pieces.

In **ICT**, we will be starting our new topic 'We are cryptographers'. We will be learning about communicating information securely and investigating about early methods of communicating over distances.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at dreams and goals. We will be discussing what we would like to be when we are grown up and what we need to do in order to achieve those goals and aspirations. We will be talking about how we feel towards achieving our dream.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists every week and will be tested on the list on the same day, the following week. Please see student's timetables to see when they have spellings. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
