We will be celebrating the vital resource of 'water' on Friday through lessons and activities designed to inspire and inform about many different aspect of water. Face paints will be available at school or this can be done at home. Hopefully all children can donate formb to our cause.

#### Literacy

In Literacy this week we will be working on improving our work. We will be focusing on up leveling the vocabulary, openers, connectives and punctuation. Then we will be presenting our work ready for display. We cannot wait for you to read our alternative endings to the story Little Red Riding Wolf!

#### **Phonics**

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In phonics this week we will review how to add the suffixes *ful, ness* and *ment* to words. This week the children will also revisit how to change singular words into plurals. We will be focusing on plurals with *s* and *es* endings and how these sometimes change the spelling of a word, for example life becomes lives. The children will also start to learn how to spell the next 200 frequency words. **Key vocabulary:** life, lives, home, homes, school, water, away, want, over, going

This week, Puffer Fish will continue to focus on using the suffix *ed*. We will also focus on using *ed* to create regular past tense verbs and learn the spelling of some common irregular verbs. Puffer fish will also practise spelling common polysyllabic words like *animals, garden, another and everyone*.

Key words: looked, listened, stopped, tripped, dried, smiled, ate, went, saw, & flew

This week starfish will be focusing on the sounds *wh* and *ph*. We will be comparing them to the previous spellings of *w* and *f*. We will be looking at them and investigating where they come in a word: *wh* comes at the beginning and *ph* at the beginning or in the middle of a word. We will then be applying our knowledge to both our reading and spelling of words in sentences.

**Key words:** what, when, which, where, wheel, whisper, dolphin, telephone, elephant, alphabet, phonics

Octopus phonics group will be learning the alternative pronunciation and spellings for *ar* and *ur*. We will be focusing on the words father, path, half, calm, word, world, work, earth and early. We will also be practising the reading and spelling of the high frequency words looked, who and think.

Key words: father, path, half, calm, word, world, work, earth, early, learn.

This week, Stingrays will recap phase 3 sounds. We will review all sound covered so far in phase 3 and recap the first 100 words.

Key words: were, come, house, from, time, came, have, went, when, some

This week sharks will start the week by reviewing high frequency words. Later in the week we will introduce the alternative spelling for 'igh' as in high, replied, line etc.

**Key words:** fright, tight, flying, crisis, cry, slice, tonight, denied, pie, strike.

Jellyfish will learn spellings of words containing the letter y. We will explore how y has different sounds in different words. For example the *igh* sound as in sky, the *ee* sound as in 'happy' and the *i* sound as in 'gym'.

Key words: flying, spying, gymnastics, crystal, goodbye, crunchy, pyramid, very, cygnet, merry.

#### Maths

Some children will be revising how to count on in 2s, 5s or 10s. We are then going to review recognising odd and even numbers. Once the children are comfortable counting in 2s, 5s or 10s we will introduce the idea of multiplication as 'lots of'. We will do lots of practical activities to help the children understand the concept of multiplication and then we will start to use the  $\times$  sign to write multiplication number sentences.

Another group of children will be going over multiplication as lots of and introduce the idea of repeated addition. We will continue to record multiplication facts using the  $\times$  and = symbols. The children will start to know the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. When they are comfortable with the idea of multiplication we will begin to understand division as grouping. The children will do this by carrying out lots of practical activities where they are grouping objects into groups and then recording division number sentences using the  $\div$ and = symbol.

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Finally some children will be using their multiplication knowledge to solve words problems. The focus will be on first identifying the key vocabulary and numbers. Then looking at how it can be represented in pictures and finally solved as a number sentence.

#### Themed Learning

Themed Learning covers our Science, Humanities and Art sessions. Teachers will be adopting a themed learning approach on a weekly or biweekly basis to allow for a more creative, cross-curricular approach to learning.

Our topic until Easter holidays will be "Planes, Trains and Automobiles", which will focus on inventions. This will be an inquiry based topic led, which will build on what the children already know and what they wonder and questions they would like to answer.

#### Humanities

The children will be finding out about the invention of a different mode of transport. They will be looking at how this invention has changed and reasons why people have changed the train or the plane. They will be culminating the next two weeks by looking at whether the invention of these ways of getting around have been a positive thing, negative thing or whether there are both good and bad points about this invention.

#### **PSHCE**

In PSHCE we will be looking at e safety and how this is important in our modern day lives. Children will be made aware of issues that can arise using computers and the internet and how they can stay safe. We will use a range of tools to show children how dangers can be averted and how trust is a very difficult thing online.
