Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your son or daughter is currently involved in the International Award programme. As part of the programme, all students are required to successfully complete an adventurous journey. To help them succeed with this, we have organised a Bronze Adventurous Journey trip to Lin'an, located west of Hangzhou city, Friday 25 April until Sunday 27 April.

The journey will involve the students trekking and camping in some of China's untouched bamboo forest. They will set up their own campsites, cook their own food, navigate and carry their own equipment.

The anticipated cost is 1450 RMB. This price includes chartered bus transport to Lin'an, qualified instructors and insurance. This also includes training in first aid, wilderness survival & cooking. If you wish your son or daughter to take part, please complete the permission slip and medical form and return it with 1450 RMB in a sealed envelope, clearly labelled "IA Bronze Trip FAO Ms Boutette" to secondary reception, by Monday 14 April. Full details of the trip will follow, including transportation arrangements and departure and arrival times.

As part of the award, students are also required to participate in planning aspects of the trip as well as attend a pre-expedition training camp-out at BISS. For safety reasons, students without the required clothing or equipment or those who do not participate in the training may not be able to attend the trip to Lin'an. The training will take place from 5:00pm on Friday 18 March until 10:00am on Saturday 19 March, at the BISS secondary school campus. I have attached a list of required equipment for your convenience. The students are required to bring these items to the pre-expedition training to verify they are ready and prepared for the journey.

Equipment Check List

Each Student

- \Box Flashlight and extra batteries
 - (Headlamp is strongly recommended instead of a hand-held torch)
- \Box Hat to provide sun protection
- \Box Waterproof shell jacket with hood
- \Box 1 wool or fleece sweater
- □ Shirts long-sleeve, light weight
- \Box T-shirts/Under-shirts synthetic is preferable.
- \Box Pants, full-length leg no jeans
- \Box Socks several pairs in case it rains
- \Box Underwear
- \Box Comfortable good-grip and sturdy/supportive shoes or boots
- \Box Extra pair sandals or trainers no flip-flops
- \Box Water bottle 1.5L 2L
- □ Put a water-proof bag, like a garbage bag inside the bag to keep all belongings dry.
- \Box Sleeping bag rated properly
- □ Sleeping mat
- \Box Food for meals and snacks for hiking
- □ Backpack, approximately 65L capable of having all supplies inside the bag (ONLY 1 backpack per student)
- \Box Gloves and warm hat
- \Box Long underwear/thermals
- \Box Extra prescription glasses, contact lens & solution, medication if needed
- \Box Personal hygiene products and toiletries
- \Box Pen or pencil



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Group Equipment

(To be divided fairly amongst members of their expedition groups)

- □ Sunscreen SPF 30 or higher, bug spray, sunglasses
- 🗆 Toilet paper
- \Box Cleaning materials for cooking pots

- □ Tent 2, 3 or 4 people per tent ** Tents can be provided if needed**
- \Box 2 cooking stoves per group and fuel (1.5 canisters per day)
- □ Cooking pots, eating utensils and cup/plate/bowl
- 🗆 First Aid Kit basic

- □ Journal, reading book
- \Box Camera in protective weather proof case
- □ Back-pack rain cover
- 🗆 Lip-balm
