The week commencing the 22 February will be our Primary Maths Week here at BISS. As well as the many exciting maths activities taking place around the school and in classrooms, we will also be raising money to support the Qing Pu Xiulong Migrant School in teaching maths.

We would like the children to bring in as many one-Yuan coins as possible so that they can use their estimating, measuring, and area and perimeter skills to create 3D mathematical signs and shapes.

We will also be having bake sales for the children in Key Stage 1 and 2. Ideally we would like all cakes/biscuits to be homemade as this will enable the children to apply their mathematical measuring skills. The children will also be in charge of selling their cakes, which will give them the opportunity to deal with money in the real world.

Could you please help us by sending in cakes or biscuits on the morning your child is scheduled to sell them to the teachers and other children, along with a small amount of money, at most 20 RMB, which will enable your child to buy baked goods.
