This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for <u>next</u> <u>week.</u>

In *Literacy*, we will be writing the story to go with a wordless book for World Book Week. An illustrator has asked us to write the words for one of his stories! By the end of the week, we will get to publish our work by taking our finished stories home.

In *Numeracy*, we will be learning how to round numbers and write numbers to 100 in digits and words.

In *Science*, we will be continuing to learn about parts of a circuit. We will learn how a switch can be used to break or connect a circuit.

In IPC, we will be learning how Art can be used to convey feelings. We will make some of our own 'feeling art' using different materials and computer programs like *Paint*.

In **PSHE**, we will continue to work in a group to create birds for our garden of dreams.

In ICT, we will be learning how to use a search engine properly and safely.

As it is World Book Week – we will be using our phonics time to take part in book related activities. Therefore, there are no **spelling** words for this week.

- Please ensure your child arrives at 7:00am, ready to be lined up for 7:10am. If your child is late they are missing Phonics the lesson which teaches them how to read in English. This is an extremely important lesson for all students, but particularly for those with English as a second language.
