Literacy

This week in Literacy children will be using their planning work from last week to create their own story board of a fable. They will then write their fable in Big Writing, thinking carefully about converting speech bubbles into direct speech.

Maths

This week in Maths we will be working with multiples and using pairs of multiples to make 100. Children will need to apply their previous knowledge of number bonds to larger numbers to complete a variety of activities and questions.

Themed Learning

Africa

In Humanities this week we will be looking at the access Africa has to water and the dangers of using untreated or dirty water. This will link into rivers in Africa such as the Nile and again reinforce the understanding of why civilisations were established and settled near rivers as it is an access to a water supply.

This week we will consider what would happen if common objects were made from different materials. We will use our prior knowledge to help form our ideas and then try to suggest alternative materials to be used. The children will then try to convince the class why their choice is suitable.

This week in Art children will continue to use paper mache to build their African masks. They will be encouraged to continue to look at their design to ensure there are achieving the correct shape.

PSHCE

In PSHCE we are looking at goal setting. We will look at some inspiration quotes and talk about the steps we need to take to achieve our goals. We will be setting a class goal and our own personal goals.
