

## **Dear Parents**

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next</u> <u>week</u>**.

In *Literacy*, students will be celebrating World Book Week. They will be exploring a book and all it has to offer. Children will be creating sock puppets and telling stories throughout this week.

In *Numeracy*, students will begin the week by investigating 3 digit number using place value cards, investigating how many different tens are in 3 digit numbers. Then we will begin to add two 3 digit numbers together using the expanded column method.

In *Science*, students will be beginning our new unit on 'Materials'. We begin by sorting materials and discussing their properties. We will then discuss how the properties of materials affect what it can be used for.

In *IPC*, students will be starting their new topics "Inventions that changed the world'. They will be creating a junk model invention as a prototype for an original idea and exploring famous inventions through research.

In *Art*, students will be using mixed media to create pictures linked to our chosen book for book week.

In *ICT*, students will be beginning our new unit from the 'Switched on Computing' scheme called 'We are communicators'. This is mainly about emailing and we will focus next week on e-safety.

For *PSHE*, students will be working on cooperating with others on book week related projects.
