Learning Theme of the week

The children were really excited to discover that a dragon had visited school last week and left them a letter to read. They have really used their imaginations well and are busy making dragon models and writing betters in reply to the dragon!



This week the majority of our learning will be about using music and movement to create a dragon dance that we can use during Chinese New Year week The children will be given the opportunity to listen to a variety of musical pieces and watch some dragon video clips. They will be able to imagine how a dragon might move and go onto create their own dragon dance and dragon path paintings. They will be encouraged to use and extend their vocabulary to include expressive words such as swoop, dive and soar. These words will prove useful as we plan to write some dragon poetry! We are also going to be challenging the children in the area of number as the dragon is keen to count its eggs that it keeps hidden in the nest by its cave-our new role play area. Here the children will also be able to check their answers by using a number line, number balances and calculators.

Some of the main learning intentions taught and explored will be:

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Children use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds. They also write some irregular common words. They write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others. Some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible.
- Children speak using past and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future.

Mathematics

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- Chilren will continue practising their counting; reading and writing numbers.
- Children will add two digit numbers using the + and = signs.
- Children will use quantities and objects as well as counting on to find answers to addition problems

Expressive arts and design

 Children initiate new combinations of movement and gestures in order to express feelings, ideas and experiences.

Physical development

• Children show good control and coordination in large and small movements

Phonics

Puffer fish-will review ear and air and introduce ure and er. Sharks-will learn ow ,oi and ear Octopus-will learn sh, ch, th, ng Jelly Fish-will lean o, c,e and u

All groups will continue to review and learn tricky words.

Mandarin

This week the children will talk about the story of Chinese zodiac and introduce Chinese New Year. What happens in Chinese New Year and what do Chinese people do. We will make dumpling on next Wednesday.

Vocabulary: happy new year xin nian hao (新年好) gongxi (恭喜) Red bag hongbao(红包) dumpling jiaozi(饺子)
