Welcome, Theresa

Absent PA Steering Committee members, Ava, Alicia,

Santa's Secret Shop, Doris

- The preparations for Santa's Secret Shop are going well. Prices for individual items will be in the range of 20-30 RMB, with some items costing up to 50RMB.
- Shopping trip on Thursday, wrapping course the following week all booked up, as are most time-slots for selling & wrapping.
- Less time will be needed for set up and break down every day as, for the first time, as merchandise will only be covered overnight, not packed away.
- Nicole has offered the staff storage room to store merchandise until market day.
- Request to parents to please speak to younger children about how many people to shop for and what they might like beforehand. Also, keep the number of people on children's lists short as they will only have 30 min to do their shopping. Staff will be on hand to help children make choices.
- Stock that has not sold for the past two years will be donated to the school and/or Roundabout.

Christmas Market, Michaela

- Schindler will provide food, 10 RMB from each sale will be donated to BSB PA
- Mulled wine has not arrived at IKEA yet.
