Learning Theme of the week

We're Going on a Bear Hunt



We will read the book **We're going on a bear hunt** by Michael Rosen and Helen Oxenbury. A family sets out to hunt a bear. Their journey is long and difficult as they come across grass, water, mud, and snow before reaching the cave where the bear is sleeping. Or rather was sleeping

Vocabulary: Swish, squelch, stumble, trip,

Role-play

We will recreate the journey including various obstacles and accompany the children in small groups while encouraging them to talk about what they can see and feel **Vocabulary:** under, over, through, wet, dry, soft, cold, dark

Mathematics

Our mathematical focus this week will be sorting and measuring. Which bear is big? Which bear is small? Which bear is the biggest? Can you put all the small bears together? **Vocabulary:** big, small, bigger smaller, biggest, smallest

As you become more familiar with tapestry, you will find at the bottom of each observation is the development matters statements. We use these on a daily basis and many activities cover several areas of learning. Below are some of the statements we will be focusing on through child initiated learning and our teacher inputs.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development - Making relationships
Shows affection and concern for people who are special to them.
Communication, Language and Literacy

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- Joins in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes and stories
- Builds up vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences

Mathematics - Numbers

• Selects a small number of objects from a group when asked, for example, 'please give me one', 'please give me two'.

Expressive arts and design - Exploring and Using media and materials

• Sings a few familiar songs.
