ENGLISH

In English we will be continuing our work on Persuasive texts. Students will be continuing their learning about the different features of persuasive texts and the language that is used to persuade the reader.

Linking to our Topic of Gateways to the World, students will be writing Persuasive texts to Airline companies to sell their Entertainment Packs that they have designed. The purpose of this will be to use convincing arguments, with strong supporting statements, explaining why their product is the best.



MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics we will be reviewing all we have covered in Fractions thus far.

In addition to this we will be looking at finding equivalent fractions.

Once we have consolidated our understanding of fractions, we will be using this to work on finding decimal equivalents. Initially this will be looking at tenths and hundredths equivalents, and based on understanding move on to quarters and halves.
