Activity	Venue	Brief Description of the ECA
Yr 3 – 4 Math's Club	Room 11	Fun math games to develop the children's confidence in this area of their learning.
Yr 3 – 4 English Club	Room 4	Have a great time improving English Language through fun and exciting activities designed around stories, songs, games and creative group projects. Restricted to pupils who are not native English speakers
Year 3 – 6 Story Telling	Room TBA	Learn to create and tell stories of your own and be able to read stories aloud to an audience
Year 5 / 6 Science Club	Science Lab TBA	Explore a range of topics and develop a passion for the wonders of science during a hands on approach.
Yr 5-6 Introduction to Design Mood Boards	Room 170	Create mood boards related to things that you are interested in. A mood board is a type of collage consisting of images, text, and samples of objects in a composition. We may even use mood boards to create a 3D room out of a box, if time allows.

Years 3 - 6 The Primary School Choir	Room 179	Do you enjoy singing? In which case this is the club for you. This is a vocal group only for Primary school children in year groups 3 – 6. The children will be rehearsing and singing a range of songs.
Years 3 - 6 Little Stars Junior Musical Theatre	Drama Room	Get involved in drama and learn to sing and play musical accompaniments to link with the dancing and acting. A great ECA for the children who like to be on the stage.
Year 3 - 4 Arabic Reading Club	Room 83	In this ECA the native Arabic students can develop their reading skills by reading popular Arabic story books.
Year 3 – 4 Hama Beads Art Class	Room 11	Learn how to create patterns and pictures using Hama Beads. A great ECA for the students interested in different art activities
Year 3 – 4 Art Club	Room 7	Work together on different art activities using various different materials, such as paint, collage and pastels.
Yr 4 – 6 Islamic Story Club	Room TBA	Develop your personal skills by linking real life experiences to Islamic cultural events and stories.
Year 3 – 6 Global Classroom	Room 167	In this ECA the children will be working on the Global classroom – online activities looking at issues such as eco ventures and sustainability. The students will have access to Ipads and will develop their technical skills
Yr 5 - 6 ICT	Primary ICT Suite	Discover new ways to research and identify various types of information as well as developing computing skills.
Yr 5 – 6 Chess Club	Room 165	Learn the ancient game of Chess whilst developing skills such as concentration, visualizing, creativity and problem solving.
