International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)

Students at the British International School, Ho Chi Minh City take the University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) International General Certificates of Secondary Education (IGCSE's) at age 15 or 16. Pass grades for IGCSE range from A*, for exceptional performance, through A down to G. Grades A*- C are commonly regarded as good pass grades.

Summary

67% A* and A

This year, students achieved another set of excelllent results. Of the 805 IGCSE's awarded to our Year 11 students, 539 were graded at A* or A, which is 67% and significantly higher than the overall British average of around 22%. This also exceeds the 61.9% within the independent school sector as reported by the Independent Schools Council (ISC). This high number of top grades is a testament to the talented and committed students and also a credit to the excellent teachers at BIS.
