This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be writing information texts and using correct punctuation within them.

In **Numeracy**, we will be using positional language to describe where objects are: e.g. left, right, under, over, in, around.

In **Science**, we will be learning about why animals can live in certain habitats. We will also be thinking about how to care for our environment.

In **IPC**, we will be completing our Exit Point for this unit. We will be recording our learning in the form of a poster and creating a party game to play.

In **PSHE**, we will be learning about bullying and recognising how bullying can make people feel.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following Thursday. **The list is now stuck into your child's communication book**. Please practice writing these words at home until your child is fluent in spelling them.
