Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for next week.

In *Literacy*, we are learning to use persuasive language to create a persuasive letter and a persuasive leaflet. These will be based on the idea of the children supporting a famous scientist to create a children's zoo.

In Numeracy, we will be using both grid method and column method to complete multiplications up to 4 digits x 1 digit. We will then focus on using the column method to calculate long multiplications using 4 digits x 2 digits. Following this, we will recap division using the bus stop method. We will also begin to use letters to create and check simple formulae.

In Science, we will be investigating mixing solids and liquids to form solutions. We will be investigating the difference between soluble and insoluble materials, before investigating how to filter solutions to separate materials.

In IPC, we will be looking at famous entrepreneurs and the impact they have had on society. We will then be looking at Futuristic Art and designing our own versions.

In ICT, we are learning to sequence events to create a story narrative. To achieve this, we are learning to; order a series of backdrop settings, narrate events with required timings and program the use of a button to change the backdrop.

In PSHE, we are working to complete the resources needed for our charity event which is taking place next week. We are creating invitations, letters, posters and objects to sell.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
