

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next** week.

In *Literacy*, students will be learning how to use apostrophes in the correct place. They will be learning when apostrophes will need to be used. Students will also be writing a recount.

In *Numeracy*, students will be recapping telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, as well as making these times on mini clocks. The students will then be learning to tell the time in intervals of 5 minutes.

In *Science*, students will investigate absorbency and will consider how to make their tests fair.

In *IPC*, students will be rating famous inventions in order of importance using their reasoning and reflection skills. They will then think of some modern day problems or annoyances. Together, they will create a think tank to come up with possible solutions to these problems and give each other feedback on their initial ideas.

In *Art / Technology*, students will continue to work as a team to make a chair. Some will then make mini-chairs with no sellotape and test them with weights.

In *ICT*, students will continue learning about emailing and adding attachments.

For *PSHE*, students will continue with the 'Healthy me' unit. They will begin creating a fitness challenge.
