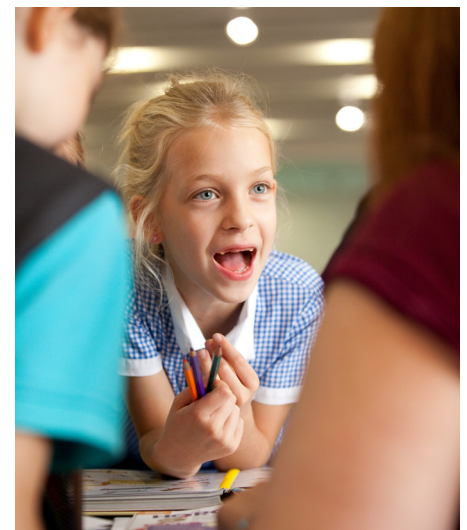

Samuel - Artist



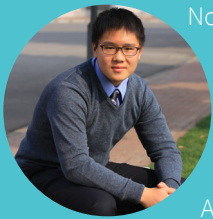
