Camp Rules-

Dads are responsible for the lads they bring with them AT ALL TIMES.

CANNOT be responsible for the safety or behaviour of the lads.

Please keep your mobile phone on you at all times so that if a lad gets lost or hurt we can contact you on the number you have provided. It is sometimes not easy for lads to find which of the similar looking tents is theirs! Please point out a meeting point (perhaps Aspretto) to any young lad so they know where to go to ask for help if they cannot find you.

- I will stay within the boundaries of the camp area and will not enter any area marked as "NO ENTRY"

General Information:

Registration and admission will take place at the Main School gate. **There will be NO admission from the Early Years entrance.** Entry will open promptly at 3.30pm and NOT before. (We need to allow the many parent volunteers enough time to get everything in order for you) Parents will need to present a school issued parent ID or other form of photo ID for entry into the school grounds.

For safety reasons there will be no vehicle access allowed beyond the gate.

Wet weather- Unfortunately we cannot control the weather and camping is an all-weather endeavor. In the event of wet weather the camp out will still go ahead. Tents will still be set up outside. (Cross your fingers for sunshine!)

Photographer-  Anna Willett will be on site to take a keepsake photograph of you and your lad/s. Photos will be taken from 15.30 until 18.00 (light depending). The photos will be distributed to the lads approximately two weeks after the event via their class teacher.

Medication- If your child suffers from any condition that may require any form of medication then please ensure this is packed with your personal belongings. (ie Asthma puffers, Epi-pens etc.)

Safety- We do not anticipate any accidents; however a basic first aid kit will be available at Aspetto. If the situation is more serious and you urgently require a taxi, a security guard at the main entrance is on duty 24 hours to call one.

Activities- 

This year's sporting activities have been kindly donated and run by multisport. Due to the large number of participants, we have arranged for the activities to take place in groups. Your lanyard/name tag will have your child's group number and activity schedule. For dads with more than one child- we have grouped your younger children together to enable you to be with them at all the activities. For dads with older children then you are free to decide which activities you join which children for.

Dinner will be catered by Blue Frog and service will be from **5pm until approximately 8pm**. Food and drinks can be purchased on the night and sample menus were included in the original registration. If you have any special dietary requirements or prefer your own home cooking, you are more than welcome to pack a picnic or bring your own supplies. A microwave will be available in Aspetto if you need anything heated. Remember though, some of our children have life threatening nut allergies so **DO NOT BRING ANY NUTS**, the school is a nut free zone at all times.

Your dinner times will be scheduled in your lad's activity groupings. This will allow us to stagger the dinner times and try to minimize queuing. Please make every effort to have dinner at your scheduled time to assist with the smooth running of the dinner service.

A parent run Tuck shop will be located in Aspetto for you to purchase additional drinks and nibbles. Tea, coffee and hot chocolate will be available to you free of charge from this stall.

Sunday Morning;-

Holiday Inn will provide a light hot breakfast on Sunday morning from 6.30am-8.30am. Breakfast is included in the cost of the event and your green breakfast voucher (which is in your family lanyard/name tag) will need to be presented to receive your order.
