

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, students will be completing their learning about newspaper reports and non-fiction texts. They will begin the week focussing on strong past tense verbs which they should use when writing their own newspaper report of a sporting event.

In **Numeracy**, students will be estimating and measuring different objects. We will be practising our measuring skills and using a range of equipment to measure capacity.

In **Science**, students will be conducting an investigation looking at hydration. We will make careful predictions and the following day will measure results through detailed observations, using our senses. We will also create Keeping Healthy posters that will be displayed around the school to promote a healthy lifestyle to our peers.

In **IPC**, students will be researching about the Stone Age Village, Skara Brae. The students will be researching about the people of Skara Brae, how they lived and will make comparisons to how we live today.

In **Art**, students will use the techniques learnt in IPC lessons to create stories in their cave paint artwork.

In **ICT**, students will complete their animations and will share them with another class. Students will have included; custom made background and characters, scripted movements using simple command programming and custom made sound effects to bring their animation to life.

For **PSHE**, students will learn how to handle being a witness to something bad, like bullying. What should they do? What can they do? How can they help? They will reflect on social stories and suggest ways in which the witness can help to solve a problem.
