ENGLISH

After the holidays, we will continue to build on the use of punctuation in our writing, this will include capital letters and full stops used accurately, the use of commas in a list. We will also try to extend our range of punctuation in the sentences we write by including a ? and !



MATHEMATICS

In maths we will re-visit number and place value

- count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0 and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- recognise odd and even numbers

Statistics

- interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
- ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity



After the holidays we will start our new topic- The Magic Toymaker.
