Science Lab Renovation – Final Phase

As we look ahead to our unique collaboration with MIT, our Secondary science students are already enjoying state-ofthe-art laboratories as two of the three phases of renovation have been completed. The final phase will introduce new work surfaces, flooring, lighting and laboratory furniture in the remaining labs. Regents is committed to delivering a 21st century education and our new Science Labs allow students to undertake practical, hands-on experimentation, to improve their laboratory skills and sense of scientific curiosity. New Primary School ICT Lab & iPads

The Lab will accommodate 25 technologically advanced workstations, and new iPads will be purchased and distributed.
