Camp rules

<u>Dads are responsible for the kids they bring with them AT ALL TIMES</u>. The event is run by Community Group volunteers; they are there to ensure the smooth running of the event but ARE not responsible for the safety or behaviour of the kids.

Please keep your mobile phone on you at all times so that if a kid gets lost or hurt we can contact you. Please point out a meeting point (perhaps Aspretto) to any younger kids so they know where to go to ask for help if they cannot find you.

General Information

Registration and admission will take place at the Main School Gate. There will be NO admission from the Early Years entrance. Parents will need to present a school issued parent ID or other form of photo ID for entry into the school grounds.

Weather

Camping is an all weather activity and in the event of wet weather the camp out will still go ahead. Tents will be set up outside. In the event of poor air quality (a reading of 200 or above) on Saturday morning the campout will be cancelled and all attendees will be informed.

Safety

The school nurse will be on site for the duration of the event and will be located in the staff room next to Aspretto. There will be security guards on duty at main entrance throughout the event should you need to call a taxi. Members of staff and the Community Group will also be present at all times.

Activities

Multisport have kindly agreed to organise and run the activities. There will be different sports and games depending on your child's age, the schedule for these will be provided at registration.

Students from Years 9, 10 and 11 are raising funds for their Project Week activities and have organised various additional activities for the kids. These include movie night, face painting, cake / pudding stall, hot chocolate sales and an X Box tournament. There will be a small charge for these activities, please bring sufficient cash.

Also available to buy will be the NAIS Pudong wristbands (10RMB) and the new hoodies (200RMB each).

Catering

Dinner will be catered by Blue Frog and Kebabs on the Grille and can be purchased on the day. If you prefer your own cooking then please bring a picnic or your own supplies. However, please remember the school is nut free, so do not bring any nuts or nut products.
