An International Curriculum

BSB offers the English National Curriculum, adapted for our international student body, and IGCSE examinations, up to the age of 16 followed by the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma programme.

English National Curriculum (ENC)

The English National Curriculum benefits from being highly structured and yet creative, from Early Years to young adulthood. At age 14 students enter two years of preparation for the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) followed by the IB Diploma in years 12-13.

German Thuringia Curriculum

Our German Primary Programme for our native German-speaking primary school students in Klasse 1-4 to study core subjects in German, following the Thuringia Curriculum, while integrating with non-core subjects and a variety of whole school activities.

Native Language Programme

We offer provision for native speakers of a range of languages, including German, French, and Chinese, and other additional language programmes as required.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

Our students also enjoy a range of foreign language programmes, starting with Mandarin from the Early Years and throughout all their schooling. Students are offered the choice of another European language (German, French, Spanish) from Year 7.

English as an Additional Language (EAL)

Our structured EAL support courses based around the Cambridge English programme ensure rapid progress for students learning English while attending our core programmes.

Sports Programme

With over 80 different teams our sport programme gives opportunities to learn, build skills and have new experiences outside of the normal classroom environment. At our school we aim to provide a very high standard of coaching and competition for our athletes as well as enable all our students to find something they can enjoy in the sports arena.



Embracing Collaboration, Creativity and Curiosity

MIT - Nord Anglia STEAM Programme

By tackling real-world challenges across the subjects of science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics (STEAM), your child will develop transferable skills such as flexibility, creativity and communication. They will be encouraged to experiment rather than wait for instructions, and will learn that collaboration and critical thinking can solve even the trickiest problems.

Nord Anglia Education is also working with MIT to introduce your child to this innovative way of learning the STEAM subjects which encourages creativity and experimentation, and teaches them how to apply their skills to real-world situations. 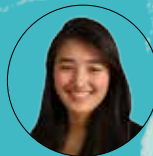

Primary - Academic Rigour

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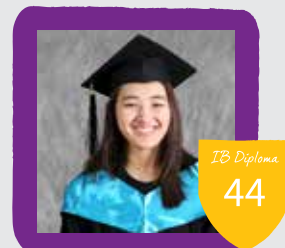
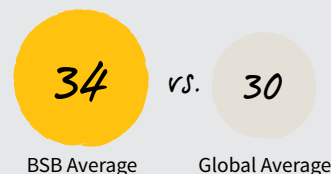
Secondary - IGCSE Results
