## ENGLISH

Next week in English we will be reading, writing and performing poetry.

The children will hear some poems being performed, thinking about what makes a good performance, before practicing poems in preparation to share them with the class.

We will also read some poems with a winter theme, looking at the form. We will study haikus and some rhyming poems, outlining their features and then use these to write our own versions.



## MATHEMATICS

In Maths next week, we will begin looking at numbers less than a whole. The children will learn to count up and down in tenths as well as learn to recognise that tenths arise from dividing an object into ten equal parts. We will develop this by learning how to divide one digit numbers or quantities by ten.

To end the week, we will revisit measures - comparing volume and mass using appropriate mathematical language.
