



# **Extracurricular Activities** in Primary (Years 1–6) Term 2 / 2017 - 2018











#### **Dear Parents**

Extracurricular Activities (ECAs) in Term 2 will start on **Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2018**. The activities will run through until **Thursday, 29<sup>th</sup> March 2018**.

Extracurricular activities provide a great opportunity for your child to take part in an activity that falls outside the realm of normal curriculum. Your child can explore their physical, creative, social or political domains and share diverse interests with like-minded students, perhaps in a different subject area or different key stage.

Children in Years 1-6 will be asked to make choices from the list of activities below. Children in Years 1-6 will have the option to choose one, two or three activities. They will be asked for multiple preferences although they will be allocated to one, two or three activities only. Not all activities are available to all year groups, please see the descriptions below. Information on paid activities can also be found within the descriptions below. This year, the sign up process will change slightly to ensure all students are granted a place on either their first, second or third choice of preference, please see the application guidelines below for detailed instructions.

#### **Application guidelines:**

- All activities (free and paid) need to be selected on-line via CHQ.
- You will be able to register your child for 1 activity during 'sign-up period 1', which will be from Monday, 4th December 2017 at 9.00am until Tuesday, 5th December 2017 at 4.00pm. You will be able to make multiple choices but at this stage you will be accepted on 1 activity. You will then be able to register your child for another 1 activity if you wish to do so during 'sign up period 2' which will be from Wednesday, 6th December 2017 at 9.00am until Thursday, 7th December 2017 at 4.00pm. Finally, you will be able to register your child for a third activity if you wish to do so during 'sign up period 3' which will be from Friday, 8th December 2017 at 9.00am until Saturday, 9th December 2017 at 4.00pm.
- After December, 9<sup>th</sup> September 2017 at 4.00pm, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the whole term. Children will not be allowed to swap activities.
- All choices will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- If students are absent from their activity without authorisation on more than one occasion, they will be removed from the activity and their place will be offered to a student on the waiting list.
- Children wishing to take part in paid activities can make payments by bank transfer to school as soon as the child's activity is confirmed. Below are the British International School Hanoi Bank details:

- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the activity.
- Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be 'closed' and the activity name will be highlighted in red
- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list.
- · Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.

## **Paid Activities**

Paid activities will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. CHQ has information about each of the activities and all details can be found by expanding the blue information tab. In Term 2, by selecting a paid activity and paying the associate fees, you are agreeing to the school's liability waiver and agree to pay the required fee. **Payments need to be made by Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> December 2017**, otherwise the place will be offered to the children who have been placed on a waiting list.

#### **On-line Activity Selection**

All activities (free and paid) need to be selected on-line via **CHQ**. Please see the next page for instructions. You will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line CHQ homepage. Please note your first choices may not always be possible.

# **CHQ - Activities and Sports Online Portal**

This system has been set up for you to use on a daily basis to select and track all of your child's chosen activities. It can be found by going to the school website <a href="http://www.nordangliaeducation.com/our-schools/vietnam/hanoi/bis">http://www.nordangliaeducation.com/our-schools/vietnam/hanoi/bis</a> and clicking on the CHQ tab, at the bottom of the homepage.

Please follow the instructions below to log on and select your desired activities.

### **Logging on**

Log on using your child's school User name and Password. If your child is in the Primary school, their Password will be their Date of Birth, in the format DDMMYYYY. If your child is in the Secondary school, their password will be 'password' or their own personal password.

# How to select your child's activities:

- Step 1: Click on My Profile tab.
- Step 2: Expand My Activities.
- Step 3: Select View/Manage/Submit Activity Choices (2017-2018 Term 2).
- **Step 4**: For each activity/paid activity add a different number e.g. Monday: Football **add 1**, Wednesday: Board Games **add 2** then **3, 4, 5 etc**. to all other clubs you would like to participate in. The **SAVE** button will appear to the right of the activity list, click SAVE.
- **Step 5**: Once you're happy with your choices you **MUST** press the **SUBMIT** button at the top of the page. You will receive an automated email confirming your club preferences.
- **Step 6**: To cancel a selection after submitting add a 0 to the desired box then save and submit.
- **Step 7**: If you click onto My Schedule after Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2017 you should be able to see your activities by scrolling through to Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2018 (start of Term 2 activities) you will also receive an email of the activities you have been accepted into and students can check display boards within school.

Once your selected activities have been approved you will be able to see them by clicking on the on My Profile tab to the right of the Home tab on your page.

# **CHQ Sign-Up Tips for Parents:**

Parents please **DO NOT** place a number 1 in each activity box as this will make your child's favourite activity unclear and as a result your child may miss out on their favourite activity). Please remember to number all choices from 1 (most important activity) to 5, 6 or 7 (or least favourite activity) regardless of the day.

Consider & discuss your choices with your child then click the **Submit** button. Clicking the **Submit** button will send your child's activity choices to school.

Please remember that you may choose as many activities as you wish that fit into your child's schedule and all activities are subject to a minimum and maximum limit.
