Messages

Literacy

This week, we will be looking at various paper and video advertisements, as part of our new topic on persuasive writing. The children will discuss their thoughts on advertisements and will identify the language features used. They will then put their persuasive skills into practice by trying to sell an object to their classmates.

Maths

In Numeracy, we will be looking at identifying fractions, of both number and shape. We will also be finding equivalent fractions and we will be starting to calculate with simple fractions.

Themed Learning

Civilisations

The children will continue to explore the Mayan period, learning about games and recreational activities. They will start to work on their own Mayan themed board game.

Science

Children will observe worms in a self-contained habitat and make predictions based on observations and research. They will work collaboratively to pose questions about the preferences of worms. Children will learn that scientific investigation also includes research skills, accurate observations and note taking under controlled conditions.

Art

We will continue to work on creating our fans, using traditional Chinese painting techniques with ink and water colour paints.

Vocabulary

Literacy – advert, persuade, magazine, trailer, preference, endorsement, features.

Maths – fractions, numerator, denominator, equivalence, vulgar, improper.

Themed Learning – habitats, observation, wormery, magnification glass, investigation, experiment.
