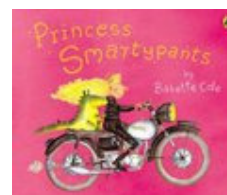
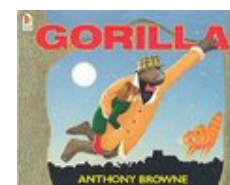
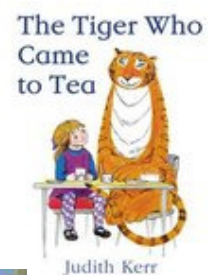
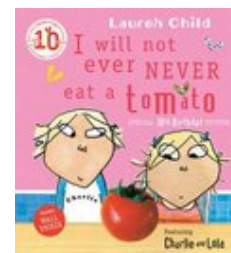
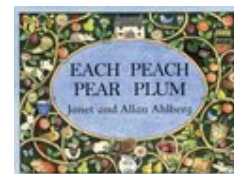




### Recommended Books: Early Years Foundation Stage
