

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we are learning the features of persuasive adverts, poems and recounts alongside taking part in our assessments. We will be assessing the children in their **Reading** and **Writing**.

In **Numeracy**, we will be learning to read and plot coordinates in all four quadrants. We will use this learning to accurately translate and reflect shapes across both the x and y axis. Following this, we will use our knowledge about the properties of shapes to calculate the missing angles in triangles, across a straight line and around a point.

In **Science**, we will be investigating what happens when solids are added to liquids, and whether any solutions are created or not.

In **IPC**, we will be researching and creating a fact file about a famous inventor, before performing a part of their lives as an act. We will also be investigating the inventions of ancient civilizations across history.

In **ICT**, we are learning to use the 'show' and 'hide' blocks in the Scratch 2 program to make characters appear and disappear in our photo stories.

In **PSHE**, we are continuing planning our charity event for 14 March. We are working on creating our resources to sell at the charity fair to raise money for Qatar charities.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following Thursday. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
