The final day of the Global Games, Awards Ceremony, and Universal Studios – New Activity!

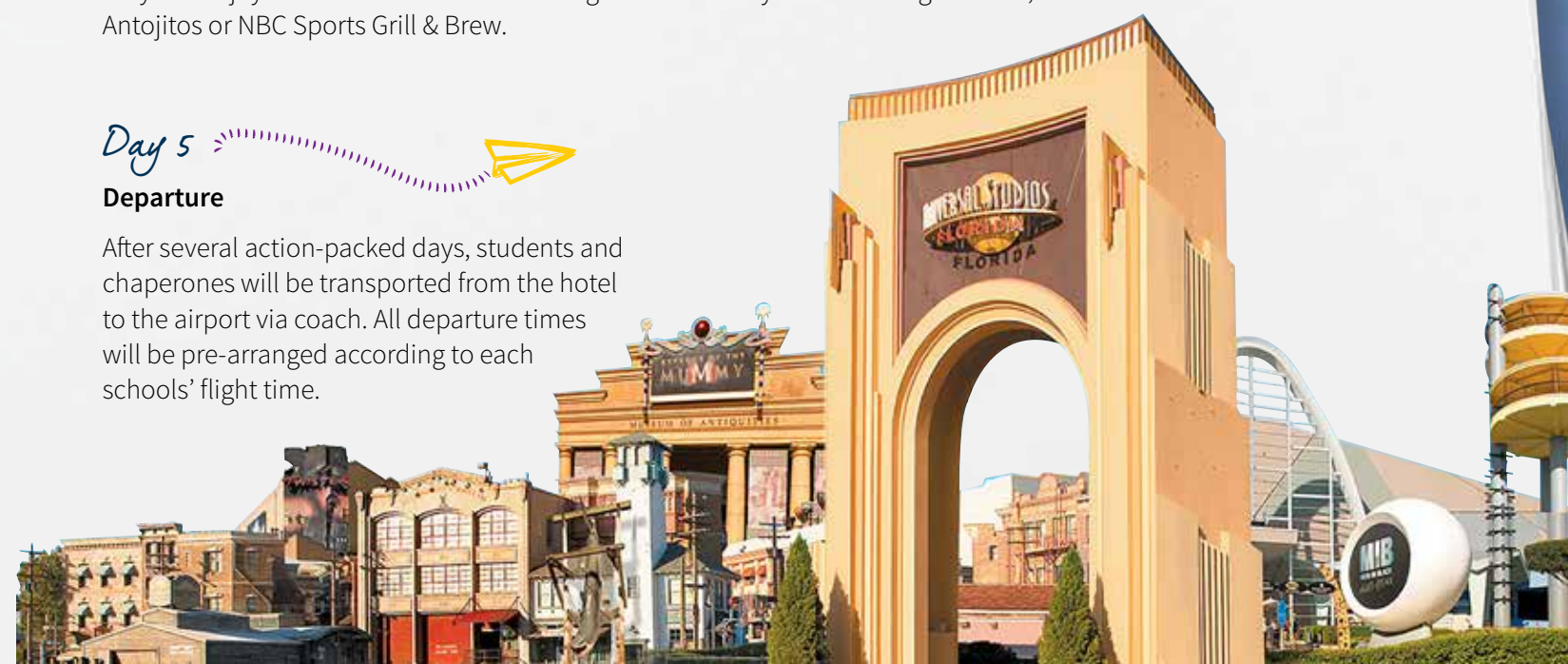

Our Venue

Windermere Preparatory School is situated on a green and spacious 48 acre campus on the shore of Lake Cypress. Your child will be competing in state-of-the-art sporting facilities.

In between competitions, your child can rest and recuperate at the Olympic Village located on the school campus. Your child can play with fun, inflatable games, relax under a tent and snack on snow cones and popcorn, all while bonding with fellow Nord Anglia students. This is also where students will re-energize with healthy, nutritious lunches catered by Caterings Best.

Accommodation

The Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista is the official host hotel for the Global Games, North America. The hotel, a 15-minute drive southeast from Windermere Preparatory School, has 2 pools, bistro, game room and convenience store, if students want to stock up on snacks or sundries.

Students from all schools will stay at the hotel from Tuesday, November 28th and check out Saturday, December 2nd. Your child will share a room with one or two other students and each student will have their own bed. Chaperones will have their own room. Windermere Preparatory School students will not stay at the hotel. Breakfast is included in the hotel rate and will be served each morning.

Flights

All school flights will be handled and booked by Nord Anglia Education, taking into account costs and timings.

It will be the responsibility of the parents to drive their student to and from the airport. Parents will need to park and check-in their student with a chaperone at the airline check-in desk.

Transportation in Florida

Nord Anglia Education, including travel between the hotel and Windermere Preparatory School and

to all evening activities, will arrange all ground transportation.

Those schools arriving into Orlando International Airport (MCO) will be transported by coach/shuttle to the Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista, and returns.

For schools in Florida, we will arrange coach buses from your child's school to the hotel and returns.





Registration, Fees and Contacts

Fees and Registration

You can register your child online for the Global Games, North America starting:

Friday, August 18th through Wednesday, September 27th, 2017.

Parents are required to register on their child's behalf. Students may not register themselves.

Upon arrival to the hotel, your child will register at the welcome desk and receive name badges, tickets and passes to evening activities, room keys and a packet with more information on the event and schedule. Times will be assigned to each school for check in to avoid long waiting lines and ensure a smooth check-in.

Coaches/chaperones

Your child's safety is our highest priority. Throughout the Global Games, your child will be assigned a chaperone to ensure that your child is supervised. Chaperones will be required to attend the entire week of the Global Games. Each chaperone will be in charge of ten students. For more information about chaperoning, please contact the Athletic Director at your school who will appoint coaches and chaperones.
