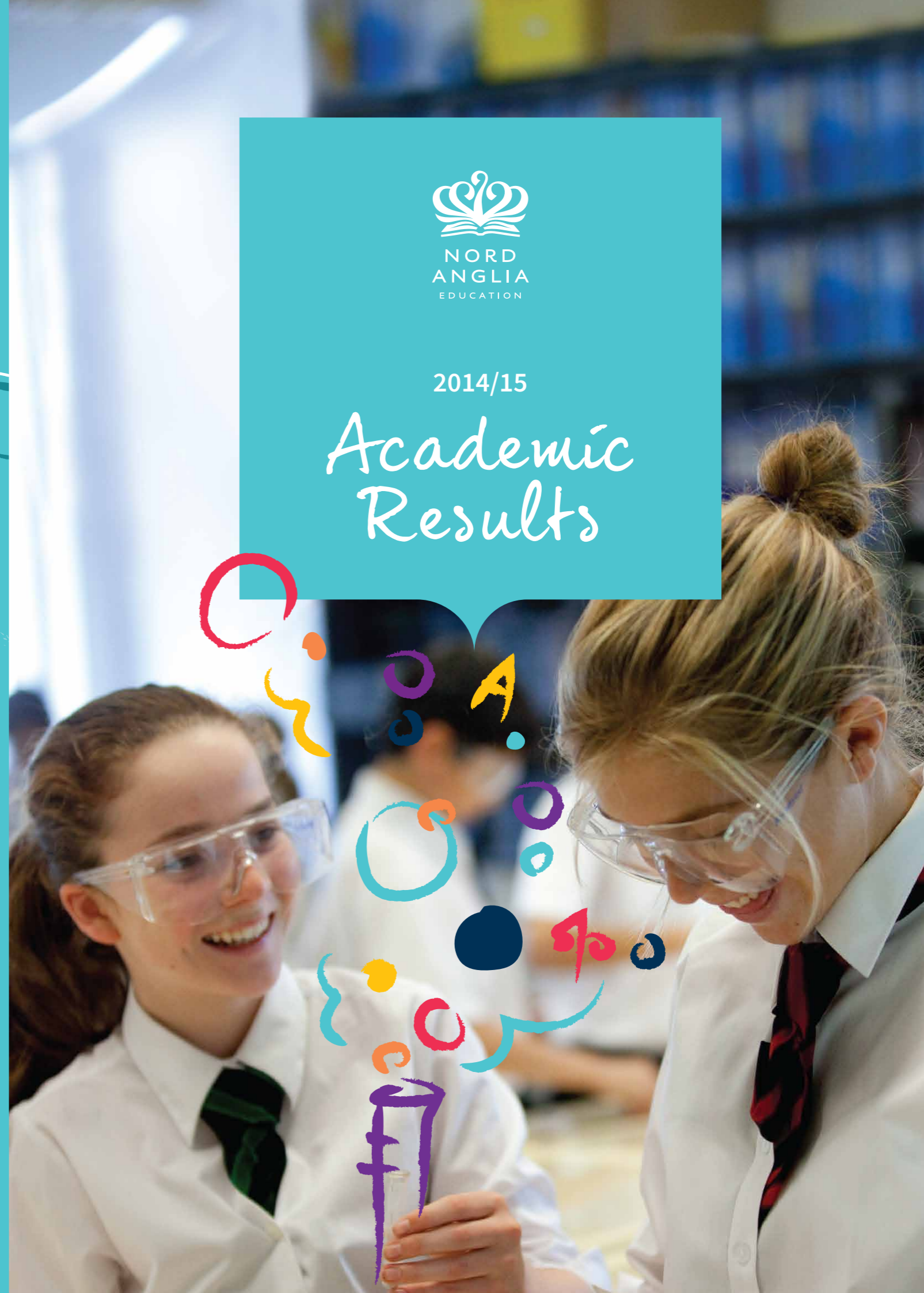

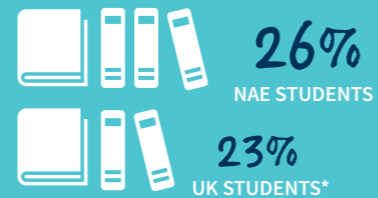
% of students aged 11 - 14

— achieving Level 3+ in English, Maths and Science



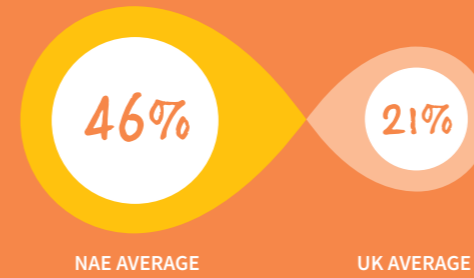
% of students in Early Years exceeding expectations

Our students continue to significantly outperform UK national averages, with our attainment levels increasing year on year

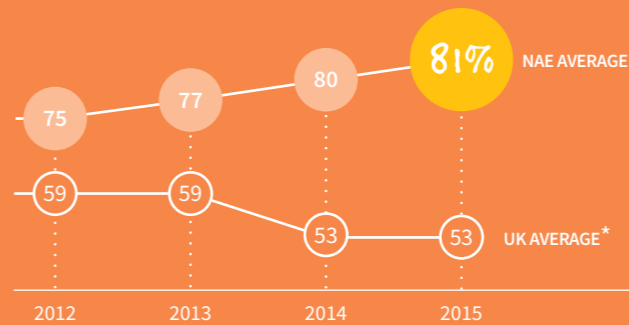
IGCSE grades at the highest levels of A\* or A

## 16-18 years old

Our IB scores are significantly higher than UK global averages. Over the last five years, our rate of improvement is six times the IB global average, widening the gap between ourselves and other IB schools around the world
