

## The week ahead in Year 1 (7 - 14 January 2018)

## **Dear Parents**

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next</u> <u>week</u>**.

In *Numeracy*, the children will be naming and recognising the properties of 3D shapes: cube, cuboid, cone, cylinder and sphere. They will begin to sort 3D shapes according to properties. The class will start to order and name the days of the week and months of the year as well as recognise and name the seasons

In *Literacy*, we will be starting a new topic of 'Rhymes and Patterns'. We will begin the topic by looking at rhyming words and discussing why words rhyme. We will then look at some short pieces of poetry and identifying the rhyming words in those poems.

In *Science*, the children will be concluding the topic of 'Being Alive'. They will be learning the importance of a healthy diet in their daily life and will be sorting healthy and unhealthy food into the different food groups.

In *PSHE*, will be learning to explain some ways why they are different from their friends and understand these differences make us all special and unique.

In *IPC*, the children will be looking at different jobs. We will concentrate on the roles people have within school and by the end of the week will be able to name some key people within the school staff. The children will also be starting their own model of Al Khor, which will include different buildings.

In *Art*, the children will be learning about the technique of drawing. They will be drawing lines and shapes using different materials and colour to create effect.
