Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next** week.

In *Numeracy*, the children will be adding 1, 2 and 3 by counting forward as well as subtracting 1, 2, 3 and more by counting back. The children will begin to add three small numbers by spotting bonds to 10 or doubles (1-6).

In *Literacy*, we are going to be looking at instructional texts. We are going to be looking closely at the features of instructions and a special focus will be on the bossy words that are used. This week we will also sequence how we get ready for school in the morning and write sentences about what we do.

In *Science*, we are going to be learning about living and non-living things. The children will be looking at the differences between them.

In *PSHE*, the children will be identifying similarities between themselves and their friends. We will be discussing what makes us unique and special.

In *IPC*, the children will be starting the world tour of different celebrations. This week we will be stopping off in Europe and looking in to a number of different celebrations people celebrate which include masks in Italy and cheese rolling in England.

In *Art*, the children will be using chalk to create a firework picture. They will be using the blending technique to show and create shadow effects.
