THE SUPPORT WE OFFER

EXAMINATION PREPARATION

The foundation of our examination preparation is outstanding teachers who are specialists in their field of study, teaching to small class sizes so that students can receive individual attention. Those teachers are supported academically and pastorally by a dedicated Head of Year 11 and Head of Sixth Form.

In the build-up to examinations, our teachers will use a range of methods to help ensure that students achieve academically to the best of their ability, ranging from extra revision classes and the provision of revision booklets and past papers, to subject clinics, mock examinations and support during study leave.

UNIVERSITY APPLICATIONS

We offer our students comprehensive guidance on the university application process. This is led by a member of staff with responsibility for providing university advice, who in turn is supported by a team of dedicated Sixth Form tutors. We run an annual 'universities evening' to familiarise students with the application process, arrange for university representatives to visit the school, assist students to attend university fairs in Bangkok and elsewhere and support applicants to prepare their essential 'personal statement' for university entry. We are also able to arrange on-site SAT classes for those students who wish to apply for North American universities.

CAREERS ADVICE

We are mindful that some students are better suited to a pathway into work rather than higher education. We have therefore developed a careers programme which is delivered as part of our Personal, Social & Health Education curriculum. We run an annual careers fair at school, the students have access to the careers section of the school library and dedicated careers software (JED) and our team of student tutors are on hand to offer their advice.
