	Literacy	Weekly update: This week the children have been continuing to develop their story writing skills. They have sectioned known stories into a beginning, middle and end and highlighted lots of the literacy features used to give an extra impact. The children have planned their own story with an inventor as the main character. They have orally rehearsed their stories so they are ready for their Target Write session next week Homework task: Children changing speech bubble conversations into direct speech and then
		make sure that all the correct punctuation is used.
	Maths	Weekly update: In maths this week the children have continued their number and place value work. We have been ordering 3 and 4 digit numbers as well as finding 1 more, 1 less – 10 more, 10 less and 100 more, 100 less of any given number. The children have also been working with multiples of 10 to add and subtract larger numbers mentally.
		Homework task: The children have been given a number ordering task to complete.

	Topic/Science	In science this week, the children have been investigating how shadows change throughout the day depending upon the sun's position in the sky. We measured our shadows throughout the day to enable us to draw conclusions about how the length and direction of shadows change over time. Our learning this week has prepared us for next week, when we will be building and using our own sundials to help us to tell the time.
