

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Numeracy**, the children will be reflecting upon their learning since the start of term. Numeracy will incorporate the theme of 'International Week' by having world flags as counting materials and other resources used to cross curriculum their learning.

In **Literacy**, the children will be writing postcards to send to different world destinations. The focus will be upon sentence structure using full stops, finger spacing and capital letters. The children will be encouraged to use adjectives in their writing.

In **Science**, the children will be looking at healthy eating and the different eating habits of people around the world. The children will have the chance to sample different cuisines.

In **PSHE**, the children will continue to learn about the differences and similarities of their friends. This theme will link in closely to the theme of 'International Week'.

In **IPC**, the children will explore four different countries found in Europe; France, England, Scotland and Italy. They will learn about the country, the weather, the cuisines and the people.

In **Art**, any different world activities will take place from creating flags, to building famous world monuments. This theme will link in closely to the theme of 'International Week'.
