Messages

- On Wednesday 29 January, we will be celebrating Chinese New Year in school.
 As part of these celebrations the children will be asked to come into school
 dressed in red or Chinese-style clothes.

- ECA lanyards- please ensure your child returns these to school daily so that their ECA teacher knows their route home after their ECA.
- Please continue to check the school website for guidelines on our school uniform policy. If your child wears warm boots or wellington boots to school please ensure they also bring indoor school shoes to change into.
- Please continue to check your child's Communication Book and folder for any important letters or communication that may be sent out.

Literacy

In Literacy we will be learning about poetry. The children will be finding words that rhyme and will take part in a guided writing session that will help them to write a short poem. They will also practice reading out and presenting their poems to the class.

Phonics

Starfish - 'er' and 'air'

Pufferfish – using all the Phase 5 sounds and words in extended writing tasks. Stringrays – blending and spelling CVC words and revising High Frequency Words learnt to date.

Octopuses – comparing the sounds 'ue' and 'oo' Jellyfish – using words to sort the sounds 'ai', 'ee' and 'or'. Sharks – alternative c and g sounds

Maths

In Maths we will continue with doubling numbers. We will look at the additions involved and develop our knowledge of place value to help us double larger numbers. We will also use our knowledge of doubles to add near doubles.

Themed Learning

Themed Learning covers our Science, Humanities and Art sessions. Teachers will be adopting a themed learning approach on a weekly or biweekly basis to allow for a more creative, cross-curricular approach to learning. Teachers may highlight specific Science, Humanities and Art skills being covered each week, but generally will provide an overview for the learning block.

Science

In Science we will continue our topic on 'Materials'. This week children will be using their senses to explore and recognise similarities and differences between materials. Children will also be introduced to the vocabulary used when describing different materials.

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Humanities

In Humanities we will continue our topic on 'Houses and Homes'. This week children will be classifying and naming different types of homes. We will continue to name the external features of a house and identify the different materials used to build homes in different climates.

PSHCE

In PSHCE we will continue our topic 'Going for Goals'. This week children will hear a story about how a girl worked hard to achieve her goal. We will then discuss and list the different ways that we can keep going when we find a task difficult. Children will then display what they have learnt about how to go for a goal in a colourful way.

Vocabulary

Literacy – rhyme, rhyming string, root, poem, nursery rhyme.

Maths – doubling, near doubles, add again, addition, subtraction.

Science – materials, bendy, shiny, soft, dull, hard, flexible, scratchy, coarse, rough, smooth, bumpy, stiff

Humanities – walls, windows, door, roof, gutter, ledge, garage, garden, detached, semi-detached, terrace, bungalow, hut, stilts, wood, brick, glass
