The Global Games is a five day multi-sport event that unites students in Grades 6 to 8 (American Schools) and Years 7 to 9 (British International Schools) from Nord Anglia Education's 11 schools across North America. Hosted at Windermere Preparatory School near Orlando, Florida, this is a fun, competitive, and action-packed event where your child will have the opportunity to go for the gold in a variety of sports:

Coaches / Chaperones

Your child's safety is our highest priority. Throughout the Global Games, your child will be chaperoned by either a coach or parent, to ensure that your child is looked after. Chaperones will be required to attend the entire week of the Global Games. Each chaperone will be in charge of ten students. Registration & Fees

You can register your child online for the Global Games, North America starting September 1st through to the 30th, 2016. Parents are required to register on their child's behalf. Students may not register themselves.

Documentation including the cost per student will be distributed during the Global Games, North America Road Show (taking place at each North American school) in August and September 2016. Also, when the registration site goes live on September 1, pricing will be available to see on the Global Games, North America web page.

Estimated Fees

The student cost differs at each school due to various factors:

- Flight cost
- Number of nights stay at Hotel
- Number of meals consumed
- Ground transportation use
- Athletic Competition Apparel

The Games Package includes

- Hotel night stay - each school varies from 3-5 nights, majority stay 4 nights.
- All meals from Tuesday night opening dinner, November 29th to Saturday morning breakfast at hotel, December 3rd.
- Games sweatshirt, swag bag & luggage tag.
- Airport transfers in Florida (round trip). For Florida schools, coach buses utilized.
- Local charter bus package (daily bus transportation in Orlando).
- Chaperone Fee (students pay a percentage of chaperone fees - hotel, meals, buses).
- Security (security guards are hired each night).
- Marketing (brochure, posters).
- Nightly entertainment (Splitsville Luxury Lanes Bowling, Dave & Busters, Magic Kingdom, Islands of Adventure).
- Sports package (referees/officials, snacks & hydrating beverages, field prep, sports equipment & set up, hospitality, first aid clinics, tournament scheduling, Olympic Village, trophies and medals).

Transportation in Florida

All ground transportation will be arranged by Nord Anglia Education, including travel between the hotel and Windermere Preparatory School and to all evening activities.

Those schools arriving into Orlando International Airport (MCO) will be transported by coach to the Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista, and returns.

For schools in Florida, we will arrange coach buses from your child's school to the hotel, and returns.

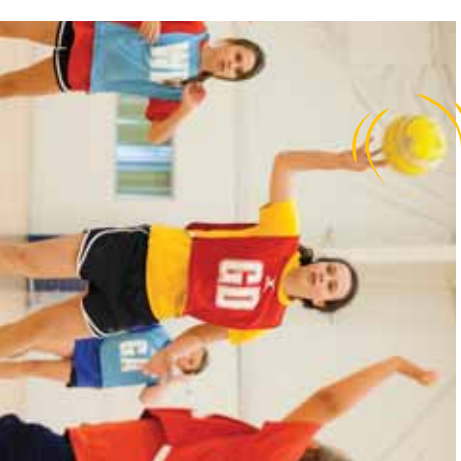
Upon arrival, your child will register at the hotel in order to receive name badges, tickets and passes to evening activities, room keys and a packet with more information on the event and schedule. Times will be assigned to each school for registration to avoid long waiting lines and ensure a smooth check-in.



Flights

All school flights will be handled and booked by Nord Anglia Education.

Roundtrip ground transportation to the airport from your child's school and vice versa will be arranged by each school's Athletic Director.





5-Day Programme

The Global Games, North America is an exciting 5-day programme packed with sports competitions, activities and the chance to make new friends from Nord Anglia's schools across the region. The programme is designed to enable your child to thrive in an atmosphere of ambition, sportsmanship and teamwork.

Day 1 – Arrival and Opening Dinner

After registering and settling in to the hotel, your child will have a chance to get to know their fellow Nord Anglia Education students as they relax by the pool. In the evening, we will celebrate the start of the Global Games with an Opening Dinner and bowling evening, hosted at Splitsville Luxury Bowling Lanes.



Your stay in Florida

Our Venue

Windermere Preparatory School is situated on a green and spacious 48 acre campus on the shore of Lake Cypress. Your child will be competing in state-of-the-art sporting facilities.

In between competitions, your child can rest and recuperate at the Olympic Village located on the school campus. Your child can play with fun, inflatable games, relax under a tent and snack on snow cones and popcorn, all while bonding with fellow Nord Anglia students. This is also where students will re-energize with healthy, nutritious lunches catered by the school.

Accommodation

The Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista is the official host hotel for the Global Games, North America. The hotel, a 15 minute drive southeast from Windermere Preparatory School, has a pool, bistro and convenience store, if students want to stock up on snacks or sundries.

Students from all schools will stay at the hotel from Tuesday, November 29th and check out Saturday, December 3rd. Your child will share a room with one or two other students and each student will have their own bed. Chaperones will have their own room. Windermere Preparatory School students will not stay at the hotel. Breakfast is included in the hotel rate and will be served each morning.

Day 2 – Opening of the Global Games and Dave & Busters

Day one of the sports competitions. Your child will participate in their first round of games and enjoy their free time between events in our on-campus Olympic Village. After a full day of competitions, students will head to Dave & Busters to eat dinner and play games - they might even win a prize! Nord Anglia Education has reserved the entire facility for our athletes.

Day 3 – The Global Games continues and Disney World

After competing in another full day of sports, your child can recuperate over dinner at Windermere Preparatory School before visiting Mickey’s Very Merry Christmas at Disney World’s Magic Kingdom.
