Messages

Literacy

We will be continuing the genre of journalistic writing. They will explore the role of bias in the media and the difference. They will consider the importance of a balanced article valuing both sides of an opinion. The students will create their own articles about 'water' based news events around the globe. The grammar focus of the week will include be apostrophes for contractions and possession. The spelling rule of the week will be adding the suffix 'ed'.

Maths

In our key skills lesson we will be developing abilities to solve multiplication and division problems. The main focus of the week will be to interpret data in different ways and understand its meaning. This will include calculating the mean, median and mode of a data in frequency charts; bar charts; and pie charts. Students will also describe and predict outcomes from data using the language of chance or likelihood. During problem solving students will develop the ability to solve word problems involving data.

Themed Learning - Water

The students will be identifying the main 'bodies of water' around the globe and their specific features; this will include exploring water currents and the effects these have on climate around

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the world. Students will be creating a water based game using the coding computer program 'Scratch'.

Vocabulary
