In Literacy, we will be revisiting the past tense, as well as looking at using apostrophes and commas in our writing before our Big Write at the end of the week.

In *Numeracy*, we will be learning how to round whole numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000 as well as looking at column subtraction.

In Science, we will continue with our new Science topic 'Electricity and Magnetism.' We will explore a simple circuit and learn about the different parts of a circuit.

Our IPC topic is 'Digital Gaming.' We will continue to use the programme 'Scratch' to create our very own games.

In Art, we will continue to draft our designs for covers of Digital Games, using key features that are necessary to promote them successfully.

In ICT, we will continue to work on our data table in an Excel spreadsheet using Doha's weather data.

In PSHE, we will continue learning about our differences using the new PSHE curriculum.
