## School Re-Opening by Sarah Osborne-James, School Principal

- Meeting held with Bangkok Pattaya Hospital to review the school re-opening plan and give the school feedback and how to quickly respond to any positive case. A memorandum of understanding (MOU), which is needed to reopen, will be given by next week.
- 2. Antigen testing will be required 2 times a week via nasal swab before students and staff return to school.
- 3. Under 15 years with a positive result can go to the hospital with a parent to confirm positivity and next steps.
- 4. There is a possibility that class closures may take place. There will be no CCA's.
- 5. After approval of the re-opening plan by the authorities, a TEAMS meeting will be held to talk through the measures and give parents the opportunity to ask questions.
- 6. Re-opening will be gradual and safe. Teachers will arrive first to assure adequate training is done. There is likely to be a staggered start for different year groups.
- 7. We have not received any further information from the authorities about the vaccination programme for students. Our list of students requesting the vaccine has been submitted and we expect to hear something very soon about the procedure.

#### **PSG Fund**

Mini, PSG Treasurer reported there is currently a balance of 63,326 baht with 20,000 baht committed to supporting Su Su Sandi, who is a scholarship student at the school.
