

- 13th IB cohort to graduate, growing from 6 graduates in 2008 to 92 in 2020
- BIS students awarded 38.0 average points compared to the world average of 29.9
- One student awarded the maximum 45 points, placing them in the top 0.21 % globally
- 43.5% of students scored 40 points or more, putting them in the top 9.4 % globally
- 32 % of students achieved 35-39 points, 21% achieved 30-34 points.
 In total, 97% of our IBDP graduates scored above the world average.

IBDP students study 6 subjects, 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL). Final results in each subject are awarded according to the 7-point grading scale as stated by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO), in which 1 is the lowest and 7 is the highest.

A maximum of 3 bonus points is awarded for successful completion of the DP core subjects of Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and Extended Essay (EE), each of which is graded from A – E. This makes a total of 45 points.


Full participation in, and completion of, the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) core element is also required.

As a school we do not rank our students, calculate GPAs or convert IB points to other scales.
