Overview

Actions

Improving feedback to parents Although we continue to see improvement in feedback to parents about their child's progress we will continue to work on this. We have introduced three reports, one per term, to provide more regular feedback to parents about their children's progress and their achievements. The format has also been more standardised across the school so parents get more consistent feedback as their child progresses through the school.
