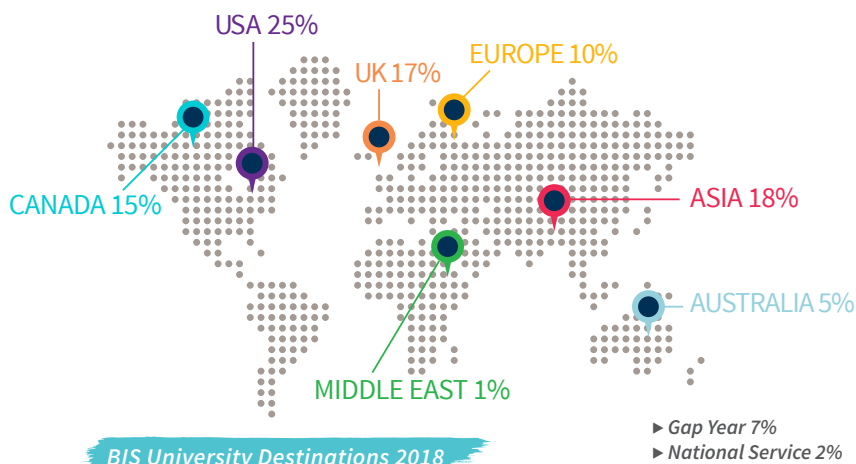

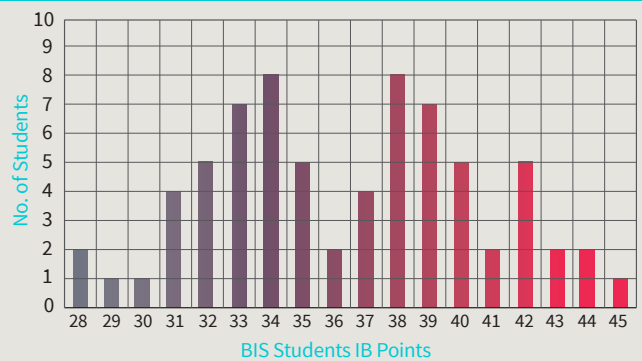

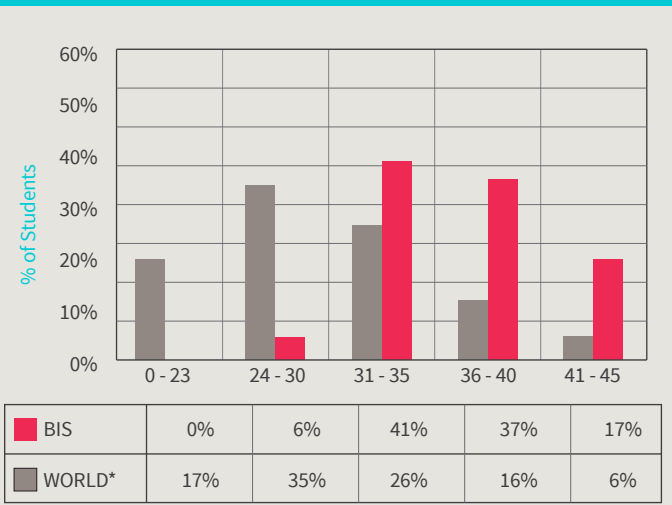

BIS IB Facts – May 2018 Examination Series

- This is the 11th IB cohort to graduate, growing from 6 graduates in 2008 to 71 in 2018
- Average points awarded to BIS students was 36.4 against the world average of 29.8
- One of our students was awarded the maximum 45 points, placing them in the top 0.44% of IBDP students in the world
- 23.9% of our students are in the top 7.94% with a diploma score of 40 points or higher
- A further 60.6% achieved 35 points, or higher with 95.8% scoring 30+ points
- 53.5% of our students scored Grade A or B for the Extended Essay, with 74.6% scoring an A or B for Theory of Knowledge
- BIS IB Diploma pass rate: 100% (IB World Average 80%)

BIS IGCSE Facts – June 2018 Examination Series

- 100% of students gained 5+ subjects at grades A* - C
- 770 out of 1129 subject entries gained A* - A, representing 68.2% of our students
- 23 students (19%) received all A*/A grades, with a further 7 students achieving 11 A*/A grades
- 65% or more students achieved A* - A in the following subjects:
 - ▶ Biology
 - ▶ Chemistry
 - ▶ Chinese
 - ▶ Computer Science
 - ▶ Co-ordinated Sciences (Double Award)
 - ▶ Design & Technology
 - ▶ Economics
 - ▶ History
 - ▶ Physical Education
 - ▶ Physics
 - ▶ Spanish
- 44 students were entered for their IGCSE Extended Mathematics 1 year early in Year 10 (Grade 9) ; 77% gained A* and 23% gained A
