








# The Curriculum: "...broad, balanced, relevant, exciting..." and based upon the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)











These prime areas are those most essential for your child's healthy development and future learning. As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in 4 specific areas. These are:




