- Go to eAdmission portal www.polyu.edu.hk/admission
- Create account and fill in application form
- Upload supporting documents
- Settle application fee of HKD 450 / -USD 57

Early Round 20 November 2018

Normal Round 15 January 2019

Extended Round 15 March 2019

02 PolyU Entry Scholarships

- Submit your application for scholarship via eAdmission portal
- Academic merits and interview performance will be considered
- The scholarship is renewable on the fulfillment of conditions

03 Offer Acceptance

- Settle the initial fee
- Join PolyU designated social media platform for Class of 2023

04 Visa Application

- Submit the hardcopy of visa application form and supporting documents by postal mail to PolyU

05 On-campus Accommodation

- Submit application of student halls of residence

06 Fulfillment of Offer Conditions

- Submit supporting documents for the fulfillment of offer conditions (conditional offer only)

07 Departure to Hong Kong

- Receive your student visa via courier
- Book your flight tickets
- Pack your belongings to Hong Kong

08 Arrival at PolyU

- Mass check-in of student halls of residence
- Attend programme registration in mid/late August
- Join orientation activities
- Semester begins on 2 September 2019

² Individual cases will be considered on their own merits by the departments concerned. Applicants may be required to attend interviews or tests to further demonstrate their language proficiency.

³ Examples of university where undergraduate research programme have been carried out: Carnegie Mellon University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Purdue University etc.

⁴ The Oxbridge Summer Programme is hosted by University of Cambridge and University of Oxford.

¹ All figures are based on Hong Kong Dollar with an approximate exchange rate at USD 1.00 = HKD 7.80. Fees and entry scholarships are subject to confirmation.

² The maximum entry scholarship of HKD 180,000 is equivalent to full tuition fee HKD 140,000 waived plus HKD 40,000 living subsidy. It is renewable subject to academic attainment.
