Trip Itinerary

Sep 16: Chengdu to Taoping Qiang Village

Departing from Chengdu this morning, it's just a short drive to Yingxiu to see the 2008 Earthquake Museum and Memorial Site. After a thoughtful tour of the exhibits, you will head to town for lunch before continuing on to Taoping Qiang Village. Once you've settled in to the guesthouse, you will enjoy a short exploratory walk to the look-out over the village followed by a guided tour of the underground waterways found at one of the local homes. After dinner, the evening will be filled with games at the guesthouse.

Sep 17: Taoping to Ganbao Tibetan Village

Today you will make the short drive to Ganbao Tibetan Village. Here you will settle in to your homestay, then spend some time touring the village before lunch. In the afternoon you will walk outside the village, where you will work alongside the locals in





their fields. After a few hours of meaningful work, you will head back to the homestay to have dinner with your hosts. Afterwards they will give you an introduction to participate in some Tibetan dancing. This is a very informal and fun way to learn some a cultural dance!

Sep 18: Bipeng Valley Trek

This morning you will head out for a full day of trekking in Bipeng Valley protected area. For the first half of the day, you will make your way towards the waterfall where you will stop for a picnic lunch. The rest of the afternoon will be spent enjoying the beautiful trek on natural trails through the forest to the lake. Returning to the village by late afternoon, your homestay host will teach you how to prepare Tibetan style momos by hand. Students will make their own momos and the host will judge for best presentation at dinner time. This evening will be spent around the campfire, roasting marshmallows and drinking hot chocolate.
