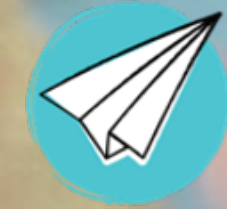

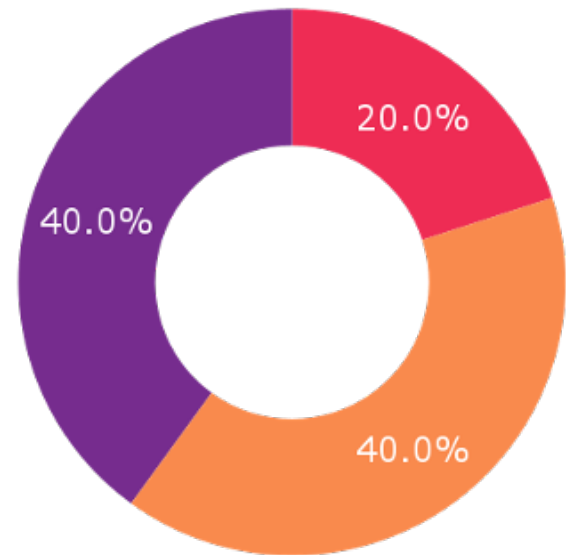

Type of activity



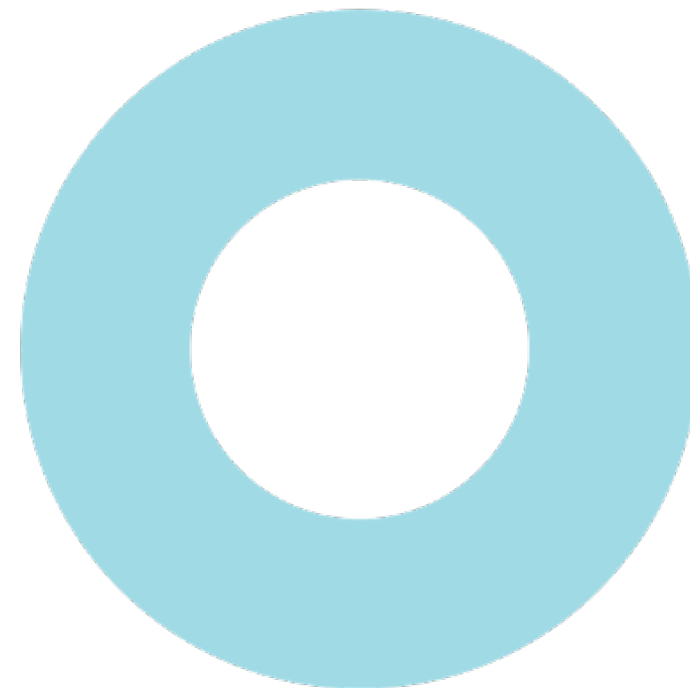
Fundraising: an event whose primary purpose is to raise money for a community partner

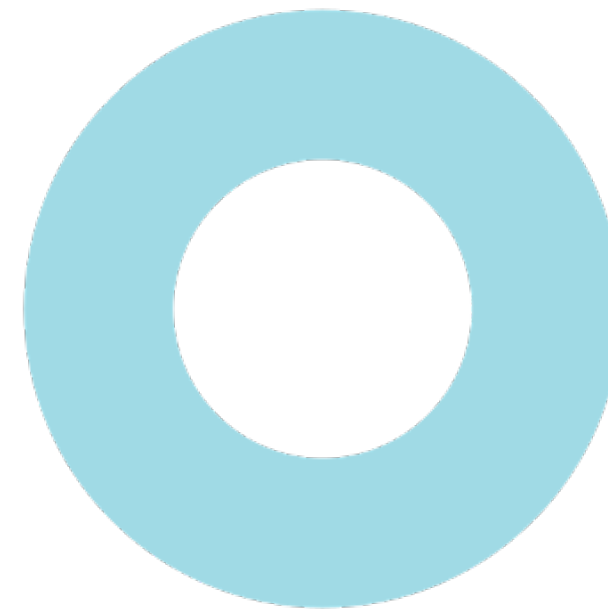

Food distribution

August 2021

Over 4,000 food parcels were distributed to the local community:

- 1,000 food parcels packed by Regents volunteers were delivered in Pong.
- 200 parcels were donated to the Food Donation Box at Pong Local Government Municipality, for local people who have no food.
- 800 parcels were given out to local people at Mabprachan Lake Park.

Feeding Pattaya Project

September 2021



The Regents International School of Pattaya provided food to those in need in their local community. Teachers and volunteers distributed 1000 survival bags containing rice, canned fish and instant noodles. Together, they raised more than 168,400 baht for this project and will continue to do so for this worthwhile humanitarian mission.

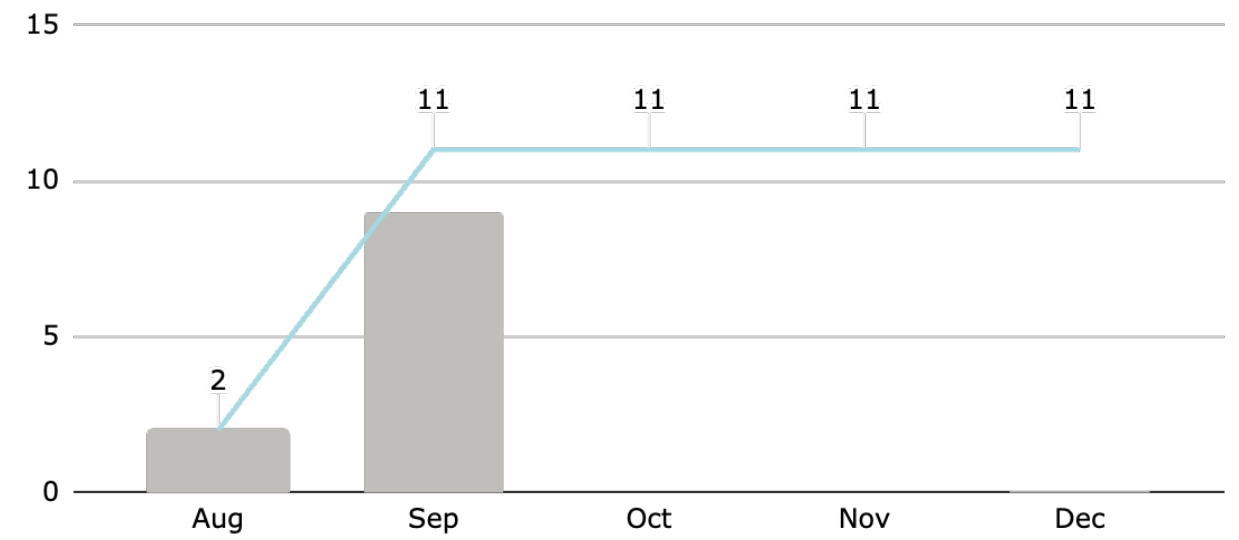

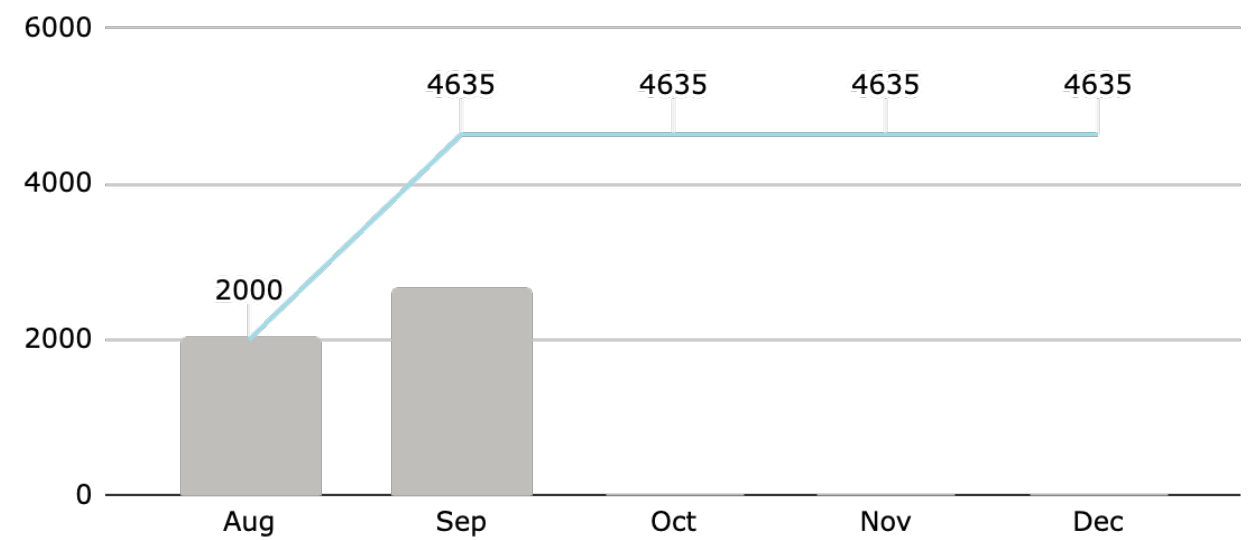
