

IB Diploma Core

- Creativity, Activity and Service
- Student complete learning experiences and a CAS project
- Extended Essay An essay conducting research into a subject area students have chosen for the diploma.



Have I talked to my parents about what I want to do?




The University Application Process



- Bridgell and UCAS building personal profile, recording personal achievements, exploring university and college courses, understanding academic requirements.
- BridgeU lessons and tasks.
- Writing personal statements and US Common App essays.
- Teacher reference letters.
- University predicted grades and Academic High School Transcripts.
- Early application deadlines.
- Regular application deadlines.
- On-line interviews/courses/on-line university visits and speakers.
- SAT examinations.
- Portfolios.
- Cambridge/Oxford Entrance Examinations.
- Other European and Canadian universities applications are direct to the university.

Students are assigned tasks to start building their profile and writing their personal statements.

UK Universities

Early applications: Beginning October – Oxford and Cambridge, Imperial College, London.

Regular applications: Submissions before the beginning of December.

Maximum of 5 Universities and 1 Teacher reference

Personal statement MUST focus on academic study with a specific focus on the course chosen.

Track offers and decisions through UCAS.

Application management
